FROM THE PRESIDENT

Did you know that Tuesday, April 8th was **Equal Pay Day**? If you attended the CREW Charlotte luncheon you received my request to visit CREW Network's website to read the statistics they had posted on where we have come with equal pay and where we are today.

"When the U.S. Census Bureau released the results of its 2012 wage gap data, it made headlines not for the progress that had been made, but rather the lack of it. Yet again, the results showed that the median earnings for full-time female workers was 77 percent of the median earnings of full-time male workers – a number that has proved



incredibly stubborn for more than a decade. Although the exact figure is hotly debated, there's no debating that a gap exists." – CREW NETWORK

While we have made cracks in the glass ceiling, we need to be the generation that shatters it. In "Lean In" Sheryl Sandberg encourages women to stop being afraid. To step out of their comfort zone and fight for the jobs and the pay they deserve. We know we deserve a seat at the table and we have proven we are worthy, but we have also learned from the generation before us that tried to do it all. While successfully running their companies by day, we have watched our mothers tirelessly keep up with our homes by night.

In "Getting to 50/50: How Working Parents Can Have it All", Sharon Meers and Joanna Strober discuss the importance of equal roles not only in the boardroom, but also in the home. They give advice on how to let go to those of us who still feel we can do it all and talk about the benefits to children of a "50/50 Home". So, while we work on shattering the ceiling to get more women in the boardroom, we need to also shatter the stigmatism around men of "50/50 Homes".
