SC on May 7, 2015. Nancy's presentation was "The Tyranny of the Standard Form". Most of us negotiate contracts every day - but too often we only look at the "deal

points" and believe the other side when they tell us that the boilerplate terms and conditions are part of their standard form and are non-negotiable. Nancy's perspective is that everything is negotiable and that boilerplate provisions are not sacred cows! She discussed about twenty different provisions that are commonly found in contracts, explained those provisions in layman's terms, and gave tips on what to watch out for and how to negotiate those provisions.
