William G. Seymour announced today that he has passed the Chief Executive title of Primax Properties, LLC to Phil C. Lanning, the current President of Primax. Seymour will retain the title of Chairman and continue to be active in the company. Holland's background, prior to joining Primax in 2013, included corporate construction management with Delhaize America and Lowe's Companies, plus private development firms and general contractors. He is a graduate of Purdue University with a Bachelor of Science in Building Construction and Technology.

Seymour commented, "This is just another step in our succession plan to insure the perpetuation of the Primax family of companies. We pride ourselves in the long term relationships with our clients and our associates at Primax. This move, along with our capital plan, is designed to make it possible to continue our track record of service to our clients well into the future. I plan to continue my involvement with the company but leave its leadership much more in the hands of Phil, Marie and Robert."
