- Our current membership is 340. We've enjoyed a 12.5% growth rate (most of it from the mid-year membership special) and 81% retention rate this year.
- We've retained 95% of our sponsors and increased sponsorship by more than 20%.
- Over 42% of our members are actively engaged on committees.

Knowledge Source

- We hosted our first ever Signature Luncheon featuring Erin Brockovich with over 400 members and guests in attendance and we've maintained an average attendance of 192 and average speaker rating of 4.8 on a 5.0 scale at our regular monthly luncheons.
- 3 of our members have served as panelists and 2 as judges for area industry events.(Please let us know if you've served as a panelist, judge or speaker so we can boost these numbers by year-end!)
- We've raised visibility and elevated brand awareness by growing our social media presence, increasing followers on 3 of 4 platforms.

Influence and Empowerment of Members

- Of the 104 members who responded to the survey question, more than 60% confirmed that they had completed/closed a transaction involving another CREW Charlotte member. Additionally, our website lists 41 posts acknowledging member-to-member business and referral generation to date.
- 3 of our members serve in leadership positions at the CREW Network level, while 8 serve on CREW Network committees and 2 are Visionaries.
- We received terrific interest in 2019 CREW Charlotte leadership, with more applications for board service than open positions.

Diversity and Inclusion

- We've conducted targeted recruiting efforts inviting potential members to select events.
- Over 40 ambassadors are fostering a culture of inclusiveness, welcoming new members and encouraging committee involvement.
- 30 of our members have volunteered over 150 hours in our community and we've raised more than \$9,000 so far in support of our outreach efforts.


