psychological safety, which is being able to show and employ one's self without fear of negative consequences of self-image, status or career. In psychologically safe teams, team members feel accepted and respected. Psychological safety is the biggest distinction in innovative teams. High-performing teams work in psychologically safe team environments. We also heard from another wonderful professional development speaker, Bonnie Hagemann, who spoke about how visionary leadership is the most lacked in current leadership. Visionary leadership is the art of seeing the invisible. Bonnie talked about how it takes courage to create a vision, because you may be wrong. However, everything you see around you was created because someone saw vision. In order to create your vision, you have to be prepared to step away from the pack, or your safety net, and be prepared for change.


